Sister Annie Mae Moore was born March 17, 1926 to the late Williams Roosevelt Stewart, Sr. and Della Brass Stewart in Wisner, Louisiana. She departed this life on March 28, 2014. The second of five children, she grew up in Franklin Parish, Louisiana and was educated in the Sicily Island public school system. Baptized by the late Rev.
