Evoria Darrington Sillers was born in Monroe, LA on October 18, 1934 to the late Julius and Earnestine Darrington. She exchanged her earthly home for her heavenly home on May 5, 2021. Evoria accepted Christ at an early age and was baptized at Free Gift Baptist Church under the leadership of Dr. Reverend B.J. Washington. Later in life, she moved her membership to St. Philip Missionary Baptist Church under the leadership of Reverend T. Williams, where she served as President of the motherboard and was a member of the choir. 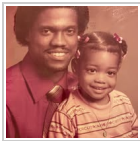
