



Mr. Louis Eugene Flournoy

December 3, 1921 - July 3, 2014

Mr. Louis Eugene Flournoy passed away peacefully on July 3, 2014, at the age of 92. He was born to Emma Rush and Oscar James Flournoy, on December 3, 1921, in Jackson Parish near Vernon, Louisiana. He attended Jackson High and maintained close ties to his alma mater years after the school closed in the 60's working with annual reunions.

During World War II he voluntarily enlisted in the U.S. Army from 1942-1945. By 1947 he had completed his bachelor's degree in Social Studies, at Southern University in Baton Rouge. There he met his wife, Mary O. Osborne who was also a student at Southern, Mr. Flournoy later went on to do post graduate work at Texas Southern where he received his Masters at Hampton Institute.

In 1947 he began his beloved career in education where he worked as a teacher and principal for fifteen years each. He began his teaching career at Caldwell High School in Columbia , LA. which he loved and where they continued to involve him as well in activities. He remained there for eleven years. He continued teaching Social Studies at Lincoln High in Ruston for several years before becoming a Master Teacher in Lincoln Parish. He was promoted to principal overseeing students at Hopewell in Dubach and later retiring from Glenview in Ruston; becoming the first African American to hold such a role after integration. He remained in that role until he retired in 1979.

He is survived by his wife of sixty-six years; Mary Osborne Flournoy, daughter Barbara McIntyre, son-in-law Ervin McIntyre, son James O. Flournoy, daughter-in-law, Marcelina C. Flournoy, granddaughters, Jamie Flournoy, Pamela & Erika McIntyre, Yasmil Rogers and Yesenia Cole; grandson's Adonis Flournoy and Anthony Winters-Flournoy; along with a host of nieces and nephews.
