A Monroe Legend and Icon Robert L. Carter is known by many nicknames. His hunting buddies call him “Mule”, and his football friends call him “Milkhead”, but being known as “Mr. C” earned him recognition in the community.

Robert L. Carter is the only child of Bob Louis and Betty Lou (B. L.) Welch Carter. He was born May 31, 1928 in Phillips, Louisiana. The seed of his values was sown very early in his life as he grew up in the Horseshoe Lake area where his Grandfather Cornelius Welch helped him master the skills of fishing and hunting. He accepted Christ as his Lord and Savior while in the Marine Corps. He attended True Vine Baptist Church.

Mr. “C” attended Monroe Colored High now known as Carroll High School, where he played football and ran track. He enrolled at Grambling College in the fall of 1948 where he played football for the legendary Eddie Robinson. However, his college education was interrupted for a tour with the United States Marine Corps during the Korean War. He leaves to cherish his memory: his wife Bettye H.
