Vickie attended elementary school at Franklin Parish Training School and, after integration, Baskin High School in Baskin, Louisiana. She moved with her family to Richwood, Louisiana, a suburb of Monroe, Louisiana. In Monroe, Vickie attended Robinson Elementary School and Richwood High School. In 1980, Vickie moved with her family to Vallejo, California. She completed her senior year of high school at Hogan High School in Vallejo.

Vickie attended college and graduated from Sacramento State University. During her undergraduate college years, she became a member of Delta Sigma Theta Sorority and remained an active

member of Delta sorority until her death. While working full-time, Vickie completed her master's degree in public health at Golden Gate University in San Francisco, California.

During her professional career, Vickie was employed by the Departments of Public Health in San Mateo and Solano Counties and by The State of California. Later in her career, she was employed with the California Employment Development Department and California Department of Industrial Relations as an analyst.

Vickie was baptized at an early age while attending Baskin Chapel Missionary Baptist Church in Baskin, Louisiana. She became a member of the Pleasant Green Baptist Church in Richwood, Louisiana. After moving to Vallejo, California, she joined the Friendship Baptist Missionary Church where she was an active choir member. Later in life, Vickie became a devoted born-again Christian. Her love for the Lord echoed in her soul. Vickie loved talking about the Lord and shared her spiritual wisdom with all those who would listen.
